This report, prepared pursuant to section 20(5) of the Social Services Law (SSL), concerns:

- A report made to the New York Statewide Central Register of Child Abuse and Maltreatment (SCR) involving the death of a child.
- The death of a child for whom child protective services has an open case.
- The death of a child whose care and custody or custody and guardianship has been transferred to an authorized agency.
- The death of a child for whom the local department of social services has an open preventive service case.

The Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) is mandated by section 20 of the SSL to investigate or cause for the investigation of the cause and circumstances surrounding the death, review such investigation, and prepare and issue a fatality report in regard to the categories of deaths noted above involving a child, except where a local or regional fatality review team issues a report, as authorized by law.

Such report must include: the cause of death; the identification of child protective or other services provided or actions taken regard to such child and child's family; any extraordinary or pertinent information concerning the circumstances of the child's death; whether the child or the child's family received assistance, care or services from the social services district prior to the child's death; any action or further investigation undertaken by OCFS or the social services district since the child's death; and as appropriate, recommendations for local or state administrative or policy changes.

This report contains no information that would identify the deceased child, his or her siblings, the parent, parents, or other persons legally responsible for the child, and any members of the deceased child's household.

By statute, this report will be forwarded to the social services district, chief county executive officer, chairperson of the local legislative body of the county where the child died and the social services district that had legal custody of the child, if different. Notice of the issuance of this report will be sent to the Speaker of the Assembly and the Temporary President of the Senate of the State of New York.

This report may **only** be disclosed to the public by OCFS pursuant to section 20(5) of the SSL. **It may be released by OCFS only after OCFS has determined that such disclosure is not contrary to the best interests of the deceased child's siblings or other children in the household.**

OCFS' review included an examination of actions taken by individual caseworkers and supervisors within the social services district and agencies under contract with the social services district. The observations and recommendations contained in this report reflect OCFS' assessment and the performance of these agencies.

Presenting Information

On 8/17/17, the SCR was made aware of the death of a 3-day-old female child. The SC was born in 2015 and according to the narrative the SC died three days later as a result of the SM's methadone and alcohol ingestion. The report also alleged the BF was aware of the SM's drug and alcohol misuse but continued to leave the SM alone with the SS.

Executive Summary

On 8/17/17, the SCR registered a report regarding the death of two children. One child, a female infant was three days old at the time of her death on 10/28/15, and the second female child died on 8/5/17. The allegations of the 8/17/17 SCR report were DOA/Fatality of the SC and other deceased child by the SM and SF, EdN and LMC of the SS age 16 and cousin (age 17) by the SM and SF, IG of the SC, other deceased child and SS by the SM and SF and PD/AM of the SC, other deceased child and four surviving children by the SM.

Regarding the female infant who died on 10/28/15, ACS learned that following her birth, the infant had remained in the hospital and was not released to the SM. According to the ACS case record, the SC died of natural causes. ACS did not conduct a full child protective investigation into the death of this SC. ACS did not contact medical providers, the local hospital and ME regarding the death of the SC. ACS did not thoroughly interview the SM, interview the SF, or explore the circumstances of the SC's death.

On 11/29/17, ACS unsubstantiated the allegations of the 8/17/17 report which included DOA/Fatality, Parents Drug/Alcohol Misuse, and Inadequate Guardianship of the child who died in 2015 by the parents.

OCFS issued a separate report # NY-17-080 regarding the child who died on 8/5/17.

LDSS Response

Prior to the 8/17/17 investigation ACS convened an ICSC on 8/10/17. ACS did not discuss the SC who died in 2015.

ACS interviewed the SM who confirmed the SC died in 2015. The SM stated that the cause of death of the SC was due to her medical condition. ACS did not obtain information from the ME or local hospital to verify the cause of the SC's death. ACS did not interview the SF to obtain further information about the SC's death.

On 8/18/17, ACS visited the local hospital and interviewed medical personnel regarding the death of the 1-day-old SS who



died on 8/5/17. ACS did not interview medical personnel or obtain medical records to confirm if the SM gave birth to a child, who died in 2015.

The 8/17/17 investigation reflected ACS investigated the death of the 1-day-old infant SS. ACS conducted a home assessment and observed the surviving children did not have marks/bruises. ACS obtained a medical consult to discuss the SM's medical condition on 8/24/17. The medical consultant did not recommend that the ACS Specialist obtain further information regarding the SC who died in 2015.
